What is a color run? This year FOC's traditional walk-a-thon will be a color run. Along with the annual coming together to walk/run the FOC trail, this year's event will incorporate several color stations along the route. Each color station will be hosted by a team of donors who will throw colored powder at participants as they pass by. Participants will be provided with a white spirit shirt to wear and will complete the event decorated in color. Each grade will be assigned a designated color in which they may choose to accessorize with accordingly. Bandanas and sunglasses will be provided to all participants to protect participants from the airborne powder.

How do I become a color station sponsor? Sponsors are needed to host the color stations disbursed throughout the course. The donation level to host a station is set at a minimum of \$5,000.
